
Mardi Market Returns Gilbert's Outdoor Market Begins Tuesday, May 4, 4-7 pm

Garden Party & Open Studio New! BronzClay

Celebrate the season! We will utilize garden elements (leaves, twigs, bark etc) and BronzClay. The result will be amazing, warm, golden bronze jewelry. No experience is needed.

Date: Tuesday, 6 - 8pm, May 18 Cost: \$25 plus \$20 supply fee

BronzClay work in progress: Rhonda made a mold of a small leaf. She pressed the metal clay into the mold to make a leaf impression. Next she cut a rectangle shape; by showing only part of the leaf, a more modern look is achieved. The metal clay was fired in a kiln. What's next? A patina will be applied to "age" the piece and make the leaf stand out more. Rhonda has plans to mold a small branch to add to the piece. Check in at Open Studio and see the finished piece.



How Charming & Open Studio

Welcome spring by sculpting tiny fine silver charms inspired by your garden*bird houses, flowers, vegetables, insects, even garden gnomes! We*II use a form of PMC that shrinks 30% when fired to produce sweet miniatures.

What would you make with a little lump of clay if you knew it would be fine silver when you were done?



Want to create on your own, but don't have the tools and materials? Come to Open Studio. Rhonda will supply tools, finishing materials, and kiln firing. You supply the imagination! You are eligible to come to Open Studio if you have taken at least one PMC class and are able to work independently. **Sign up 24 hours in advance.** Dates: May 4, May 11, May 18

Cost: \$20 plus cost of PMC products. You may bring your own PMC. Open Studio is free for students completing a class project.
