THE LEFT BANK STUDIO: Surface Design class begins Saturday, January 14th at 10-12 noon at The Left Bank Studio in Gilbert. Jo used to paint yardage for interior designers and painted coats, bags and pillows for galleries and shops.

Starting on January 14th, Jo will be teaching Surface Design and how to paint companion fabrics to create art quilts, pillows, bags, vests, hats, and canvas floor coverings. Students will be using dyes, inks, permanent pens, silk screens, stamps, stencils, rubbings, enamels, latex and numerous texture-making techniques.

Students will accomplish one project per class. There will be emphasis on color, value, light and dark contrasts, pattern, shape, line and dominance. Jo will provide some patterns and sketches for you to work from. For a small lab fee, paints and dyes will be provided for your use.

Fabric painting/Surface Design class will be held at **The Left Bank Studio in Gilbert** on Saturdays at 10-12. Call Jo at 515-233-1405 to register or get more information. Cost is \$25 per class and additional lab supply fee. Examples of Surface Design projects below:
